

Magdeburg before the war:

In the early 17th century, Magdeburg was not only a city of the Hanseatic League¹, but an archbishopric² as well. During the reformation it became an important centre of the protestant confession. Furthermore, it claimed to have the status as a free city³. To keep this very status, Magdeburg was a neutral city for a long time in the Thirty-Years War. After the first siege⁴ of Magdeburg, it formed an alliance with protestant Sweden.

- 1: = union of merchants in medieval times ("Hanse" or "Hansestadt").
- 2: = administration of a certain territory within the ranks of the catholic church.
- 3: Free cities were only in command of the emperor.
- 4: military forces surrounding a city to take over.
