That you defended Cage at all is what prompted my writing the phrase you found so strange, which, yes, was partially intentionally ironic (since 4' 38' basically consists of *nothing* on a page), while also serving to point out the very fact of your defensive attempt (what I mean is that you must respect Cage or his work in some way to even bother defending him). Of course I respect "you" as a person, even if I've never met you before. That's just pure civility, But I cannot respect Cage's music qua music, since I find it more of a mockery of art rather than some avant garde whatever-have-you. I whole-heartedly agree that beauty can be found in unexpected places. But call silence silence, and music music. That's really the brunt of my entire line of commentary. I must strenuously disagree with any attempt to redefine art or music. Constant calls for and attempts at redefinition are (largely, though not only) what has gotten our world into the kind of cultural troubles we see all around us. God and religion, art and music, male and female, morality, truth, metaphysics - none of these things mean what they used to, and so modern man by and large feels lost, or (even worse) "doesn't" feel lost, but rests content with anything less than the eternal.
