Between Italian grammar and medieval buildings: Courses of Italian Language and Culture for Foreigners at the University of Bologna (25.06 – 27.07.2012)



The city of **Bologna** preserves the traces of **past civilisations** and the **character of medieval splendour**. Avidly visited by the **Romantic writers** and **celebrated for the arts and culinary excellence**, Bologna is animated by a **cosmopolitan culture** that is enriched by the **presence of the University**.

The **University of Bologna (www.unibo.it)**, probably the first University in the western world, is now promoting the 2012 edition of the **Summer School of Italian Language and Culture**.

The courses are organized with the cooperation of the Department of Foreign Language and Literature and the Interfaculty Centre of Applied and Theoretical Linguistics (CILTA).



Courses are offered in three different options: a **two-weeks Intensive Course for Beginners (level A1, A2, B1, June 25th – July 6th 2012)**, a **three-weeks Course for Beginners, Intermediate and Advanced (A1 and all superior levels, July 9th - 27th 2012)** and a **combination of both Courses**, for a total duration of **five weeks (June 25th - July 27th 2012)**.



Each format includes **50 hours of class teaching, cultural visits** and **optional week-end field trips**, so allowing students a better fluency in the Italian language – both written and oral – and a deeper, more direct exposure to the Italian culture and traditions.
